We source our fruit exclusively from Marlborough, New Zealand, and hold Appellation Marlborough Wine certification, representing the highest standards of viticulture and authenticity in New Zealand. Only 29% of New Zealand wineries have this certification, and Whitehaven the only AMW-certified top wine under \$20 sold in the U.S<sup>1</sup>.
